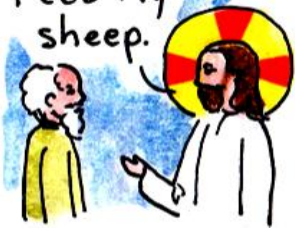

Feed My sheep.

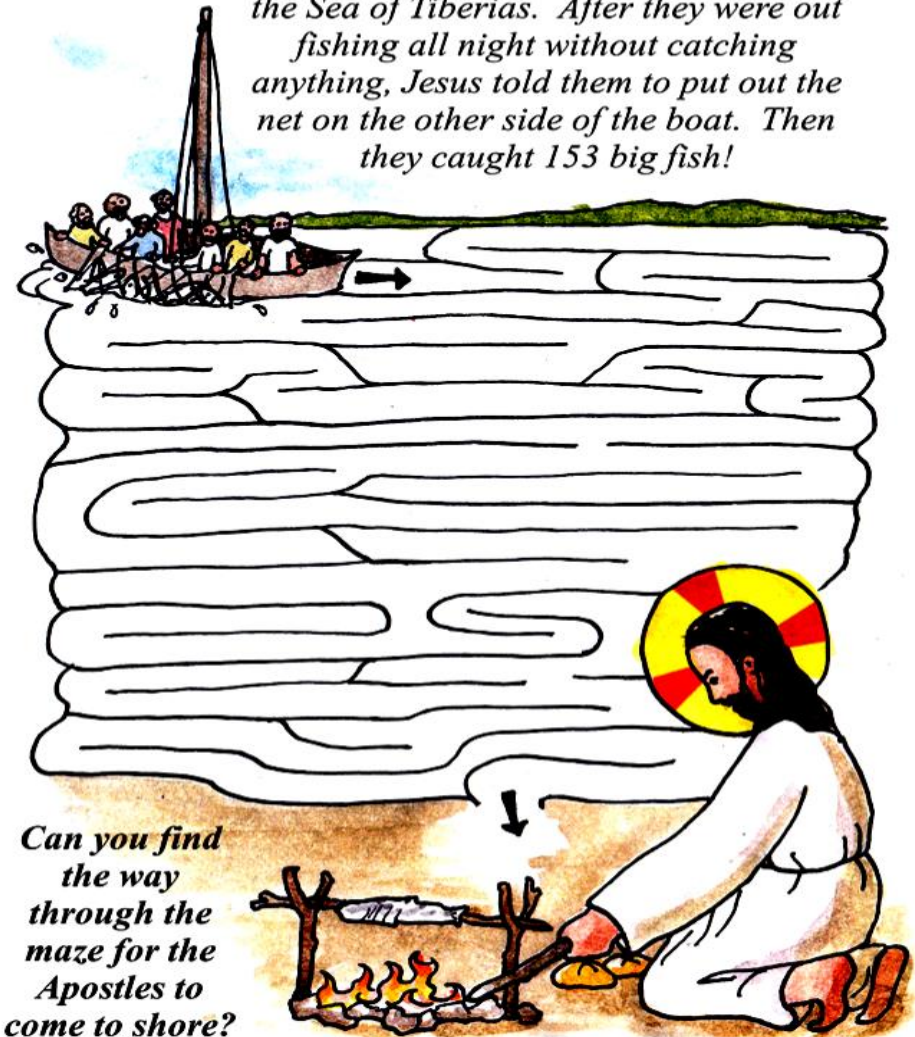

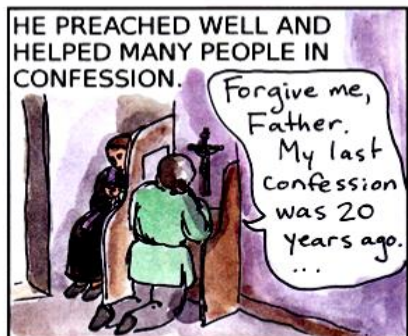
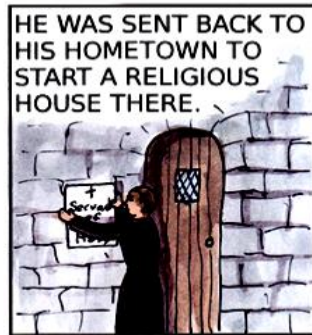
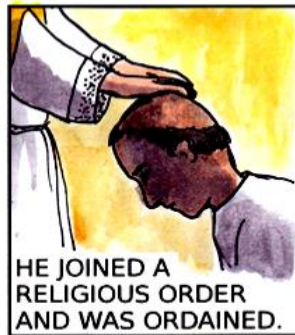
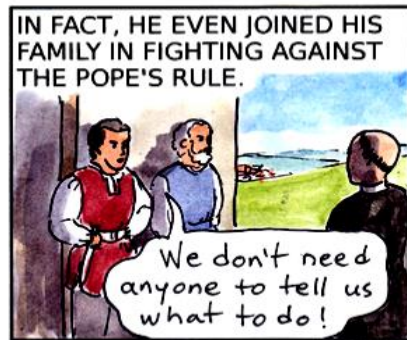


Can you find the way through the maze for the Apostles to come to shore?

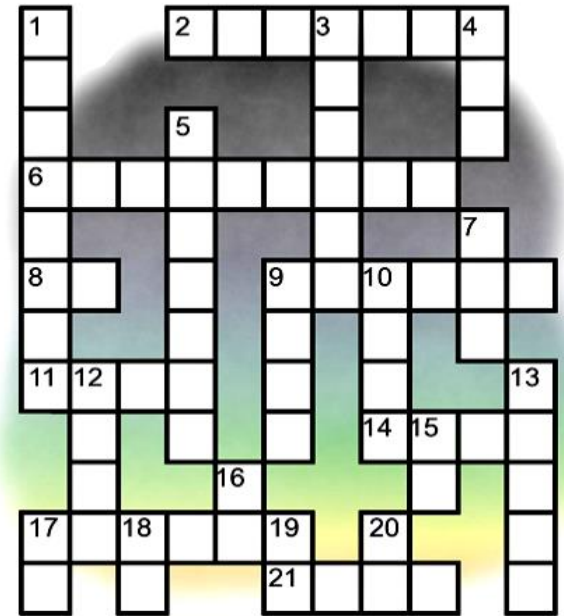
